

Shellharbour City Youth Art & Design Exhibition Guidelines

Shellharbour City Council is calling for local young artists who would like to exhibit their work at the Shellharbour Civic Centre to celebrate Youth Week 2025.

The Youth Art & Design Exhibition will be held from Monday 7 April to Wednesday 30 April with the official launch on Wednesday 9 April.

Artworks can include any of the following categories - mixed media, sculpture, ceramics, photography, digital media, jewellery, animation, design and textiles.

Exhibition

- Artists are responsible for delivery and pick up of all works. Artwork must be delivered before Monday 31 March between 8.30am - 4.30pm and collected from Thursday 1 May to Friday 9 May.
- Artwork will need to be framed, ready to hang or placed in display cabinets. For all hung work; Dhooks must be attached.
- Information is to be provided for artwork signage.

Eligibility

- Artist must be aged between 12- 24 years
- You need to live in the Shellharbour LGA
- Be visually appropriate and suitable for people of all ages;

Shellharbour City Council can refuse an artwork because of technical restrictions, sensitivity or ethical reasons. For example, we will not accept artworks that display racism, offensive language or communicate negative ideas about other people.
